

RESIDENTIAL CARE AND MAINTENANCE FOR WOODEN FLOORING

Lacquer

Preventive Measures

- Be careful with heavy appliances and furniture. Support them with wide bearing, no-staining glides or casters. Appliances can be moved into place by sliding them slowly over the floor on a clean piece of carpet turned face down.
- A doormat both inside and outside any external door can prevent the ingress of dirt and grit that could otherwise cause considerable wear to your floors.
- Remove any existing metal or plastic domes on furniture and replace with Kährs felt floor protectors to avoid unnecessary marks to the floor. (These are stocked in our showroom)

Cleaning

- Vacuum or sweep floor daily or as needed to prevent accumulation of dirt or grit that can scratch or dull the floor.
- Mop floor with a well wrung out mop using Kährs Cleaner or a neutral cleaning agent that has a PH of no more than 8 for example mild dish washing detergent (without ammonia)
- Never pour water directly on the floor or allow water to lay directly on the surface of your floor.

Removing Marks

Marks from	Remove using
Asphalt, rubber, oil, shoe cream, tar, soot or dried in residues of chocolate or fat gummy substance	Wipe with damp cloth. If any remains, wipe with methylated spirit, benzene or similar
Wax, crayons, lipstick, felt pens, ink Candle wax, chewing gum	Methylated spirits or white spirits Coolant spray or place plastic bag containing
Canule wax, chewing guin	ice cubes on the mark and then carefully scrape off
Blood	Cool water
